**AMISH PASTE** 85 d indeterminate Wisconsin heirloom; sauce and canning, heavy yield, good flavor, large, meaty, bright red, up to 8 oz.



**ANANAS NOIR** 85 d (Black Pineapple) Large, dark-purple fruits averaging up to 1.5 lbs, with a distinctive, streaked interior of pink, red, green and yellow.



**AOSTA VALLEY** 65 d indeterminate. From NW Italy; short-season; exceptionally rich flavor. Prolific clusters of 10–12 small (1½”) shiny red. Excellent fresh or sauce. Blight resistant.

**ARKANSAS TRAVELLER** 85 d indeterminate. Heirloom, 6-8 oz, abundant, sweet flavor, pink.

**AUNT RUBY'S GERMAN GREEN** 80 d indeterminate. Heirloom large beefsteak, 12-16 oz, excellent unusual flavor, chartreuse when ripe.

**AUSSIE** 85 d indeterminate. Heirloom from Australia. Dependable 1 lb-2 lb, glossy-red, meaty, fluted, beefsteak tomatoes. Great disease resistance.

**BE MY BABY** 65 d indeterminate Productive cherry with a rich sweet flavor.

**BELLSTAR** 70 d determinate. Round paste, 4-6 oz., compact plants can be grown in containers, resistant to cracking.

**BERKELEY TIE DYE PINK** 65-75 d indeterminate. Beautiful 8-12 ounce fruit with a very sweet, rich, dark flavor. Port colored with metallic green stripes.



**BIG ITALIAN PLUM** 75 d indeterminate large, red, 8-12 oz., paste type tomatoes that resemble fat banana peppers. Excellent for thick paste tomato and canning.

**BISON** 67-75 d determinate Heirloom from North Dakota. Dwarf, compact container plant; needing no staking. Huge amounts of 2”-3”, red, round; exceptional, rich, complex and slightly acidic flavors. Great canning and salad.

**BIZHIKI SLICING** 75 d indeterminate Fantastic flavor, crack resistant. Uniform bright red 3” globe-shaped.

**BLACK CHERRY** 65 d indeterminate Abundant black cherry fruit. Abundant, sweet fruit.

**BLACK KRIM** 75-90 d indeterminate. Heirloom, 10-12 oz, solid, rich flavor, dark brown-red color.

**BLACK PRINCE** 75 d indeterminate. From Irkutsk, Siberia. Iridescent 5–7 oz. garnet-colored fruits are uniformly handsome. Outstanding flavor.

**BLACK ZEBRA** 85 d indeterminate 4 oz., 1 1/2”, juicy, round tomatoes with purple/mahogany-colored skin with green stripes (like brush strokes). Exceptionally rich, complex tomato flavors with hints of smoke and sweetness. Great for looks and taste.

**BOBCAT** 65 d F-1 hybrid. determinate Big Beef type with impeccable looks, disease resistance, slightly flattened round 10–13 oz., thin skins and excellent taste. Flavor mild with a spicy sweet accent and slight acidic complexity, color medium red.

**BOX CAR WILLIE** 80 d indeterminate Prolific yields of smooth, reddish-orange fruits averaging a large 10 to 16 oz. Ideal for canning, freezing, or for home-cooked meals. Crack-free and disease resistant.

**BRANDYWINE** 80 d indeterminate. Amish heirloom with legendary flavor. Pink-red fruit, 16 to 24 oz.

**BRANDYWINE, Weaver's Black** (True Black Brandywine) 85 d indeterminate. Oldest of the Brandywines. Crimson, with shadows of green, purple, brown.

**BRANDYWINE Yellow** 80 d indeterminate. Amish heirloom with legendary flavor. Warm yellow fruit, 16 to 24 oz.

**BULGARIAN TRIUMPH** 78 d indeterminate Bulgarian heirloom, very productive, extra-sweet, juicy, red, 2-inch, 3-4 oz., oxheart-shaped, thick-walled fruits. Great for canning.

**BUSH BEEFSTEAK** 62 d determinate. Compact, vigorous plants, 8 oz rich fruit.

**CARMELLO** 75 d indeterminate Among the most productive tomatoes ever bred. Bears large crops of heavy, great tasting fruit, even in cooler weather. Good for slicing in salads, sautéed, or as an integral part of any dish. French.

**CEYLON** 75 d indeterminate. Unique, multi-ribbed, flat shape. Productive and disease resistant. Great taste, 2”-3”.

**CHEROKEE GREEN** 76 d indeterminate One of the best green es. Medium-sized, 8-plus oz., some yellowish-orange color on the blossom end when ripe. Bold, complex flavor.

**CHEROKEE PURPLE** 80 d indeterminate. Heirloom from Tennessee, rose/purple fruit, 10-12 oz sweet rich fruit.

**CHOCOLATE STRIPES** 79 d indeterminate 3-4 inch, mahogany-colored with dark, olive green-stripping. Flavor is delicious, complex, rich, sweet, earthy. Produces well into the autumn A great sandwich tomato and salad tomato.

**COSMONAUT VOLKOV** 65 d indeterminate. Considered by Fedco to be “the best.” Will produce even in cold weather, red, sweet flavor, Russian heirloom.

**COSTOLUTO GENOVESE** 78 d indeterminate. Italian heirloom, deeply ribbed, flavorful, full flavored and delicious.

**DAGMA'S PERFECTION** 73 d indeterminate. Medium-sized, slightly flattened, pale-yellow with light red striping. Overtones of tropical fruit and subtle hints of lime. Firm, juicy and elegant and jewel-like in appearance.

**DEBARAO** 72 d indeterminate. Russian plum, good for sauce or fresh eating. Deep red.

**DONA** (VFNT hyb) 65 d indeterminate. French variety, large harvests, flavorful, red, 6 oz.

**EARL OF EDGECOMB** 73 d Indeterminate Heirloom from New Zealand. Attractive orange globes, in clusters of two or more. Uniformly ripening fruits are smooth and regular in shape, defect free, and resistant to cracking, blossom end rot,

**EARLY ANNIE** 60 d short determinate Heirloom produces high yields of 4 oz., round, meaty fruits with few seeds. Particularly good for canning. Fruit sets all at once.

**ELFIN** 54 d determinate Vigorous short, bushy plant that produces massive bunches of 3/4-inch, grape-like, (plum to pear shaped) fruits. Extra flavorful and crisp snacking tomato.

**EVA PURPLE BALL** 74 d indeterminate Creamy texture with a balanced flavor. Round, dark pink, and blemish-free. 4-6 oz. fruits. Heirloom from the Black Forest of Germany.

**GERANIUM KISS** 68 d dwarf indeterminate Massive clusters of 1/2 - 4 oz. red fruits with pointed blossom ends borne high on stocky 1 1/2 - 4 ft plants, a great container variety. Late Blight resistant.

**GERMAN, ELMERS OLD** 80 d indeterminate From Germany. Yields 1-2 pound (and more), deep-pink, heart-shaped; delicious, bold, sweet/acid flavors with very few seeds. Excellent slicer for eating fresh.

**GERMAN JOHNSON** 70 d indeterminate. Heirloom, pinkish, excellent flavor. Fruit is up to 1 lb.

**GERMAN QUEEN** 79 Days Very big potato leaf plants produce lots of sweet, pink, 1-2 lb., meaty, beefsteak tomatoes. Perfect for slicing.

**GEZAHNTE** 80 d lovely paste-type, originating in Naples, Italy. Lavishly pleated up to 6 ounces. Semi-hollow, firm and mild-tasting; great for stuffing. Very productive.

**GLACIER** 56 d determinate. Rich-flavored early red.

**GOLD MEDAL** 75-90 d indeterminate 1-lb fruit bi-colored yellow fruit; blushing with rosy red radiating from the blossom end. Firm. sweet and mild. Very little acid.

**GRANDMA MARY'S PASTE** 68 d indeterminate. Heirloom paste. Good production in cool weather.

**GREEN DOCTORS FROSTED** 79 d indeterminate Oval cherry. Blush gold when ripe. 5' rambling plants; prolific producers and resisted Late Blight.

**GREEN ZEBRA** 80 d indeterminate. 4-5 oz green and yellow with sweet flavor. No cracking.

**HEINZ** 2653 68 d determinate. Early red plum for sauce.

**HOG HEART PASTE** 86 d indeterminate. Ital-



ian heirloom meaty 6-8 oz, long paste, excellent flavor, canning or fresh eating. (vines are wimpy, but strong)

**HONEYDROP CHERRY** 62 d indeterminate Open-pollinated. Compared to Sun Gold; less cracking in wet weather.

**IDA GOLD** 59 d determinate. 2-bite gold, low acid. Good producer.

**ISIS CANDY** 67d indeterminate 1-inch round cherry, yellow with red tinge and marbling. Rich and fruity.

**JASPER CHERRY** hyb 60 d F-1 indeterminate Deep red globes on small clusters. Instant juicy sweetness. Vigorous vines defy Late Blight. Almost never crack. Very early, very prolific, very disease resistant.

**JERSEY DEVIL** 80 d indeterminate American heirloom. Abundant crops of 5-6" long, tapered, bright red, paste tomatoes with pointed end, few seeds; very good taste Meaty sauce tomato and a good choice for making salsa.

**JET STAR** 72 d compact indeterminate Prolific quantities of cosmetically perfect 7-8 oz globes with outstanding flavor. Resistant to F1 and V.

**JUBILEE (Golden)** 80 d indeterminate. 8 oz, heirloom, orange, excellent flavor, fine texture.

**JULIET** 60 d indeterminate Delectable little plum-shaped fruits in clusters everywhere, 12-18 1-2 oz. grapes to each truss and an astounding 50-80 per plant. Glossy red fruits; full sweet tomato flavor. 1999 AAS winner. Crack resistant, tolerant to LS and LB.

**KC 146** 75 d semi-determinate. aka Campbell's 146. 5' plants produce a plethora of 9 oz. red round fruit; good rich flavor. Good for canning.

**LILLIAN'S YELLOW** 88 d indeterminate. Superb

creamy consistency, 1-lb fruit. Balance of engaging sweetness and intriguing citrus quality.

**LONG KEEPER** 75 days semi-determinate perfect tomato variety for winter storage. Plant produces huge amounts of 6 oz round fruits. Popular for its good taste and long storage ability.

**MARGLOBE** (VF) 70 d determinate Classic French, good flavor, abundant producer, 8 oz scarlet fruit.

**MARIZOLE RED** 85 d indeterminate From the Black Forest region of Germany. Very productive, 14-16 ounce, slightly flattened, bright red, beefsteak with outstanding flavor for sandwiches, salads, or cooking.

**MARK TWAIN** 85 d indeterminate Deep red, full-bodied flavor. Good-sized, crack free, ribbed 8-24 oz. oblate fruits in September. Heirloom with great taste.

**MASON MARVEL** 81 d indeterminate. Large pink beefsteak with great flavor and few seeds. Late-blight resistance

**MATT'S WILD CHERRY** 60 d indeterminate. Very small red and extremely sweet. Grows wild in Mexico. Abundant.

**MORTGAGE LIFTER** 85 d indeterminate. Deep pink 1-2 lb beefsteak. Medium cover, regular-leaf foliage, grows in clusters of 2 or 3.

**MOSVICH** 60 d indeterminate. Heirloom; 4-6 oz. red. Rich taste, cold-tolerant.

**MOUNTAIN SPIRIT** 77 d indeterminate New medium-to-large 10-15 oz yellow-red bicolor by combining many popular tomatoes then selecting for production, vigor and fruit quality. Resistant to cracking and disease, good yields great overall performance.

**MOUNTAINEER DELIGHT** 77 d indeterminate, Late Blight resistant, large red beefsteak.

**MOUNTAINEER PRIDE** 80 d indeterminate Medium red slicers, good flavor, great disease resistance. Holds well on the vine. Late Blight resistant.

**MR FUMAROLE PASTE** 65 d indeterminate Large elongated 3"-6" pinkish plum, very flavorful, sweet meaty good.

**MULE TEAM** 79 d indeterminate. Heirloom. Moderate yield of 3", 8-12 oz. globes. Excellent mildly sweet flavor. Plant bears continuously till frost.

**NEPAL** 75 d indeterminate Heirloom from India's Himalaya Mountains. Abundant, 6 to 10 -oz., smooth, round, scarlet-red fruits; little cracking and intense sweet flavor. A great keeper.

**ORANGE BANANA** 80 d indeterminate. Orange, paste-type, 3 to 4 inches long. Vigorous producers, sweetly-flavored. Good for salads, salsa, sauce.



**OREGON SPRING (V)** 58 d determinate. Cold-tolerant, compact plants, medium to large red fruit, good flavor.

**PAUL ROBESON** 78 d indeterminate. Russian heirloom. Maroon-brick red with sweet smoky taste/ Sandwich size.

**PINEAPPLE** 85 d indeterminate. Heirloom with red and yellow streaks, up to 2 lb fruit, Flavorful. Abundant.

**PINK PRINCESS** 62 d indeterminate. Pink-fruited. Large and early for a cherry. Slow to give in to Late Blight.

**PLUM REGAL** 75 d determinate Productive plum with Late Blight resistance. High yields of blocky, 4 oz. plum. Deep red color with good flavor.

**POLISH LINGUISA** 73 d indeterminate Polish heirloom. Excellent yields of huge, 10-ounce, 2-inch x 5 inch, sausage-shaped, very meaty, bright-red, paste tomatoes with firm flesh and few seeds.

**PRINCIPE BORGHESE** 75 d determinate. Plum-shaped meaty for drying. Very prolific.

**PRUDENS PURPLE** 72 d indeterminate. Flavorful heirloom, dark pink fruit, delicious flavor, good production.

**PURPLE CALABASH** 80 d indeterminate. Truly purple. Fluted, almost ruffled in appearance. Flavor is distinctly winy and rich. Large harvest.

**RED PEAR** 78 d indeterminate. Miniature, pear-shaped. Bright red and flavorful.

**RIESENTRAUBE** 75-85 d Sweet, red 1-oz fruit grow in large clusters. Full flavor that is missing in today's cherry types. Large plants produce massive yields.

**ROMA(VF)** 78 d determinate. Most popular paste.

**ROSE DE BERNE** 80 d indeterminate. French medium-sized smooth pink globes; robust flavor; rich sweetness.

**RUBY GOLD** 90 d indeterminate Prolific beautiful huge red-streaked yellow fruits with marbled interior flesh, meaty with superb mild sweet flavor, smooth melting texture. Gigantic 1-3 lb fruits.

**RUTGERS (FVAG resistant)** 75 d indeterminate Developed by Campbell's Soup Co. in 1928. Outstanding slicing, cooking and canning . Old-time flavor.

**SAN MARZANO (VFNT hyb)** 80 d indeterminate. Elongated paste tomato, bright red.

**SEBASTOPOL** 75 d indeterminate Vigorous tomato plants with 3/4-inch, red cherry tomatoes: sweet tasting with a spark of tart flavors.

**SHEBOYGAN** 80 d indeterminate. Productive pink paste, 6 ounces and subtly tapered to a rounded tip.

**SIOUX** 70 d indeterminate. Heirloom with incredible flavor and large yields. 6 oz round red.

**SOLDACKI** 80 d indeterminate Heavy producer, sandwich size, pink, flavorful. Heirloom from Poland.

**SPECKLED ROMAN PASTE** 85 days indeterminate. Red cylindrical fruits covered with orange-yellow striations. Abundance of meaty 4-5 oz. fruits which make a flavorful sauce.

**STUPICE** 52 d indeterminate. Heirloom from Czechoslovakia. Cold-tolerant, 1 to 2 oz, flavorful, sweet. Long producer.

**SUN GOLD (hyb)** 57 d indeterminate. Apricot-colored, Delicious & sweet cherry . Vigorous producer.



**TEN FINGERS OF NAPLES** 72 d determinate. Wonderful paste tomato producing compact plants that yield huge crops in long trusses of 5-6", 3 oz., elongated tomatoes with a pointy end. Disease resistant.

**TIFFEN MENNONITE** 86 d indeterminate. Comparable to Brandywine.

**TIGERELLA** 55-75 d Tasty round, bright red with orange stripes; 2-inches. Quite beautiful. High yields, early producer. Good disease resistance. Originating in England.

**TROPHY** 80 d indeterminate. Introduced in 1870 in Rhode Island. Sweet, mild flavor, 5-7 ounce, round. Ideal for slicing.

**TROPICAL SUNSET** 65 d indeterminate Orange and rosy red streaks this true mini bicolor sports. 1 1/4" tender-skinned round cherry with fruity sweetness and mild acid balance.

**VILMS PASTE** 82 d indeterminate Small vibrant 4 oz. blood-red, firm with excellent tart-sweet flavor and meaty solids. Pear shaped, plum shaped or double lobed. Productive. From Sweden.

**WAPSIPINICON PEACH** 78 d indeterminate Two bite, heirloom tomato with a nectar-like, juicy flavor. Light yellow fruits with tinges of pink and a touch of fuzzy peach like skin.



**WEISNIGHT'S UKRANIAN** 85 d compact indeterminate Scrumptious pink tomato; somewhat flattened globes; rich and somewhat tart, not real sweet.

**WOLFORD'S WONDER** 90 d indeterminate, Large, 10-16 oz., 4 x 5-inch, deep pink, firm, heart-shaped, tomatoes with thick, skins, and few seeds. Exceptionally juicy and very tasty.

**YELLOW PEAR** 2 d indeterminate Introduced in 1934 in North Dakota. Each plant produces about three dozen sweet tasty 1 oz fruits. Crack resistant.

**YUKON QUEST** 90 d indeterminate From Australia Dwarf container plants (3-feet tall) produce 6 oz., pink tomatoes with excellent, sweet flavors that rival Brandywine.
